

THE TRADING (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1968

AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND THE TRADING ACT 1966

Date of Assent : 27.2.68.

Date of Commencement : 1.3.68.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Trading (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 19 of Act No. 6 of 1966

2. Section 19 of the Trading Act, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended in subsection (6) by —

(a) the deletion in paragraph (c) of "months." and the substitution of "months; or";

(b) by the addition of the following paragraph —

"(d) is not at the time of his appointment either —

(i) a citizen of Botswana; or

(ii) entitled to reside in Botswana in accordance with the provisions of the Immigration Consolidation Law, 1966."

Amendment of First Schedule to Act No. 6 of 1966

3. The First Schedule to the principal law is amended by the addition of the following paragraph —

“Speciality Licence

17. (1) The holder of a speciality licence shall, subject to the provisions of section 45, be entitled to trade in any goods other than —

(a) those for which in terms of this Schedule a chemist, fresh produce, petrol filling station, restaurant, hide and skin buyer or produce buyer licence is required; and

(b) foodstuffs (including tinned and frozen foods, flour and meal) soaps, washing powders, household detergents, paraffin, methylated spirits and household cleaning materials.

(2) A speciality licence shall, subject to the provisions of section 20 (2), be restricted to the fixed premises specified therein.”.

Amendment of Second Schedule to Act No. 6 of 1966

4. The Second Schedule to the Principal law is amended by the addition of the following item —

“SpecialityR50”
