In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Commissioners of Oaths Proclamation (Chapter 50) the Minister of Home Affairs hereby gives notice as follows —

1. This Notice may be cited as the Commissioners of Oaths (Amendment of Schedule) Notice, 1968.
