THE FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961

DECLARATION OF PRIVATE GAME RESERVES

(Published on 5th July, 1968)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8(1) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (No. 22 of 1961), His Excellency the President hereby declares the areas of land described in the Schedule to be private game reserves for the protection and preservation therein of wild animal life; subject to the following conditions –

- (a) persons authorized thereto in accordance with the provisions of section 16, as read with section 9, of the said Proclamation, may hunt game on the said land in accordance with the provisions of the said sections as read with section 49 of the said Proclamation;
- (b) the holder of a Minister's licence granted under the provisions of section 31 of the aforesaid Proclamation, may hunt game on the said land in terms of section 9 of the aforesaid Proclamation.

SCHEDULE

- A. The following farms situated in the Tuli Block –
 - Portion 1 of the farm Charter Reserve No. 6 – MS' ;
 - Portion 2 of the farm Charter Reserve No. 6 – MS' ;
 - The Remaining Extent of the farm Charter Reserve No. 6 – MS', known as the farm "Santhata";
 - The Remaining Extent of Portion 1 of the farm Safari No. 1 – MS, known as "Majali";
 - Portion 2 (a portion of Portion 1) of the farm Safari No. 1 – MS, known as "Dopotta".
- B. The following farm situated in the Tati Concession Area –
 - Farm No. 99 – OQ.
