THE FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961

**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (BATAWANA TRIBAL TERRITORY)
HUNTING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1968**

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 (1), as read with section 93, of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, and after consultation with the Chief of the Batawana tribal territory and the appropriate District Council, the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs hereby makes the following regulations —

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Batawana Tribal Territory) Hunting (Amendment) Regulations, 1968.

Addition of Regulation 14 to S.I. No. 65 of 1967

2. The Fauna Conservation (Batawana Tribal Territory) Hunting Regulations, 1967 are amended by the addition of the following regulation —

“Exemption from Provisions Relating to Tribal Game

14. The provisions of these regulations relating to the hunting of tribal game shall not apply to a member belonging to a community which is entirely dependent for its living on hunting and gathering veld produce, and who is himself so dependent, where the animal is hunted for the reasonable food requirements of the hunter or of the members of the community to which he belongs.”.
