**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961**

**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1968**

(Published on 22nd March, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 93(2) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, (No. 22 of 1961), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs hereby makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (General) Regulations, 1968.

**Forms**

2. The forms in the First Schedule may be used for the purposes of the Proclamation and these regulations.

**Commutation of Export Duty by Holders of Package Licences**

7. The holder of a package licence issued in terms of section 20A of the Proclamation may commute in advance the export duty which may become payable by him in terms of section 64 of the Proclamation by paying to a licensing officer the sum of fifty rand in respect of a package licence "A", forty rand in respect of a package licence "B", and thirty rand in respect of a package licence "C", as the case may be.

**Form of Distinctive Mark on Ivory and Rhinoceros Horn**

8. Ivory and rhinoceros horn marked under the provisions of section 69(1) of the Proclamation at the Game Department Office at the place listed in the first column hereunder, shall bear the distinctive mark prescribed in the second column hereunder stamped upon the ivory or horn and shall be numbered consecutively, commencing with the number "001" —

**Powers of Honorary Officers**

9. Honorary officers appointed in terms of section 89 of the Proclamation shall have the powers conferred upon a game officer under the provisions of sections 81, 83 and 88 of the Proclamation.
