THE MINES AND MINERALS ACT, 1967

THE MINES AND MINERALS (GABBROIC ROCK) DEEMING ORDER, 1968

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2(3) of the Mines and Minerals Act, 1967 (No. 50 of 1967) the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs, after consultation with the Tribal Authority of the tribal territory concerned, and with the Central District Council, hereby directs for the area near Moreomabele, the boundaries of which area are described in the Schedule hereto, that where the winning and working of gabbroic rock is for the purpose of disposal to another party for profit, such rock shall be deemed to be a mineral for the purposes of the said Act.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at the intersection of Longitude 27° 10'E with Latitude 22° 00' South to its intersection with Longitude 27° 30' East; thence southwards along Longitude 27° 30' East to its intersection with Latitude 22° 07' South; thence westwards along Latitude 22° 07' South to its intersection with Longitude 27° 10' East; thence northwards along Longitude 27° 10' East to the point of commencement.
