THE IMMIGRATION (CONSOLIDATION) LAW, 1966

**NOTICE EXEMPTING MEMBERS OF CLASS OF PERSONS FROM OBTAINING A
RESIDENCE PERMIT TO RESIDE IN BOTSWANA**

(Published on 12th July, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 19(2) (c) of the Immigration (Consolidation) Law, 1966 (No. 19 of 1966) the Minister of Home Affairs hereby exempts members of the class of persons referred to in the Schedule who are in possession of valid passports from obtaining residence permits in order to reside in Botswana.

2. Legal Notice No. 97 of 1966 and Statutory Instrument No. 7 of 1967 are revoked.

SCHEDULE

- (1) Officers in the Public Service of Botswana other than persons employed in the Gaborone Water and Electricity Unit ;
- (2) employees in the Rhodesia Railways ;
- (3) the wives and minor children of persons referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) ;
- (4) members of the United States of America Peace Corps ;
- (5) persons recruited by —
 - the International Voluntary Service ;
 - the Voluntary Service Overseas ;
 - the Special Commonwealth African Assistance Programme ;
 - the British Ministry of Overseas Development ;for service in Botswana.
