THE IMMIGRATION (CONSOLIDATION) LAW, 1966

NOTICE EXEMPTING MEMBERS OF CLASS OF PERSONS FROM OBTAINING A RESIDENCE PERMIT TO RESIDE IN BOTSWANA

(Published on 11th October, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 19 (2)(c) of the Immigration (Consolidation) Law, 1966 (No. 19 of 1966), the Minister of Home Affairs hereby exempts from obtaining residence permits in order to reside in Botswana members of the classes of persons referred to in the Schedule who are in possession of valid passports or, in the case of minor children, have their names endorsed upon a valid passport held by a parent hereby exempted:

SCHEDULE

1. Employees of the University of Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland.
2. The wives and minor children of persons referred to in paragraph 1.
