THE POST OFFICE PROCLAMATION, 1961

**THE TELEPHONE, RADIO, POSTAL AND FRANKING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,
1968**

In exercise of the powers vested in him under section 105 of the Post Office Proclamation, 1961 (Proclamation No. 43 of 1961) His Excellency the President hereby makes the following regulations —

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Telephone, Radio, Postal and Franking (Amendment) Regulations, 1968.

Amendment of Fourth Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 23 of 1963

2. The Fourth Schedule of the Telephone, Radio, Postal and Franking Regulations, 1963 is amended in paragraph 4 by the addition at the end thereof of the following proviso

“Provided that for the years 1967 and 1968 no fee shall be payable in respect of any listener's licence issued in respect of radio apparatus distributed by the Government under the Freedom from Hunger Campaign Farm Broadcasting Scheme.”.
