AN ACT TO AMEND THE APPEAL TRIBUNAL (SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS) ACT, 1966, BY INCLUDING WITHIN ITS SCOPE AN APPEALS BOARD APPOINTED UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE BOTSWANA INDEPENDENCE ORDER, 1966

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Appeal Tribunal (Supplementary Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1969.

Amendment of Long Title of Act No. 3 of 1966

2. The long title of the Appeal Tribunal (Supplementary Provisions) Act, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended by the deletion of "Tribunal appointed in terms of section 112(2) of the Constitution" and the substitution therefor of "certain Appeal Tribunals".

Amendment of Section 2 of Act No. 3 of 1966

3. Section 2 of the Principal Law is amended by the insertion after the word "proceedings" where it first occurs of "and to an Appeals Board appointed under section 11 of the Botswana Independence Order, 1966, and its proceedings".
