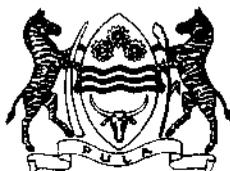


THE BRANDING OF CATTLE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1969

AN ACT TO AMEND THE BRANDING OF CATTLE LAW, 1961, SO AS TO ENABLE THE PRESIDENT BY ORDER TO AUTHORISE THE IMPRINTING ON THE CHEEK OF ANIMALS OF BRANDS ADDITIONAL TO ZONAL SYMBOLS AND REGISTERED BRANDS IMPRINTED UNDER SUBSECTION ONE OF SECTION SEVEN OR SUBSECTION ONE OF SECTION TWENTY-THREE

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Branding of Cattle (Amendment) Act, 1969.

Amendment of section 23 of Law No. 19 of 1961

2. Section 23 of the Branding of Cattle Law, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended by the addition of the following subsection —

“(3) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1), the President, if satisfied that in particular circumstances the imprinting on animals of any particular class of brands additional to registered brands imprinted under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section and zonal symbols imprinted under the provisions of subsection (1) of section *seven* would be warranted, may by order published in the *Gazette* authorise the imprinting in such circumstances of such additional brands, whether registered or not, on the cheek of animals of such class.”

Amendment of Section 24 of Law No. 19 of 1961

3. Section 24 of the principal law is amended in subsection (1) by the insertion after “symbol” of “or a brand authorised under the provisions of subsection (3) of section *twenty-three*”.
