

**THE EDUCATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1969**

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE EDUCATION LAW, 1966, SO AS TO ENABLE ORDERS ESTABLISHING BOARDS OF GOVERNORS TO PROVIDE FOR DELEGATION TO COMMITTEES OF CERTAIN FUNCTIONS OF SUCH BOARDS AND SO AS TO REQUIRE THE MANAGER OF EVERY PRIVATE SCHOOL TO KEEP DETAILED RECORDS OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE WHICH MAY BE INSPECTED BY AUTHORISED OFFICERS.**

**Short Title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Education (Amendment) Act, 1969.

**Amendment of Section 9 of Law No. 40 of 1966**

2. Section 9 of the Education Law, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law), is amended in sub-section (1) by the addition in paragraph (g) immediately after "Board" of —

“including the delegation by the Board to Committees thereof of such functions involved in the duty of management as the Minister may consider appropriate in the circumstances.”

**Amendment of Section 21 of Law No. 40 of 1966**

3. Section 21 of the principal law is amended by the insertion of the following subsection after subsection (1), the present subsection (2) becoming subsection (3) —

“(2) (a) The Manager of every private school shall keep up-to-date records of revenue and expenditure giving details of receipts including all fees and other payments received for or from pupils and any grants, donations or subscriptions towards the running of the school, and of expenditure including salaries, books bought (with titles, individual prices, numbers of copies and total cost), stationery (with quantities, prices and total cost), and other items (with amounts, prices and total cost as may be appropriate in respect of each item), and shall prepare or cause to be prepared by the 1st September in each year in respect of the year ended on the preceding 31st December, a balance sheet and a receipts and payments account including the details above specified, which balance sheet and account shall have been audited by an independent auditor approved by the Director.

(b) All records and other documents kept or prepared in terms of this subsection may be inspected at any time by an officer authorised by the Director.”

**Amendment of Section 27 of Law No. 40 of 1966**

4. Section 27 of the principal law is amended in subsection (5) by the deletion of all words following “subsection (1)”.
