**AN ACT TO AMEND THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ACT, 1967, SO AS TO
REQUIRE TWENTY-EIGHT DAYS' NOTICE TO THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL OF
PETITIONS FOR ADMISSION.**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Act, 1969.

Amendment of Section 6(1) of Act No. 34 of 1967

2. Section 6 of the Legal Practitioners Act, 1967, is amended in subsection (1) —

- (a) by the deletion of "ten" and the substitution therefor of "twenty-eight";
- (b) by the deletion of the proviso and the substitution of —

“Provided that the Attorney-General, in his discretion, may accept service for a lesser period and, if he does, shall notify the Registrar in writing thereof.”
