AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARIES OR DUTY ALLOWANCES TO BE PAID TO THE HOLDERS OF CERTAIN OFFICES SPECIFIED IN SECTION 124 OF THE CONSTITUTION.

Date of Commencement: 1.8.69.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as *The Specified Offices (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1969*.

Salaries of the Chairman and Members of the Public Service Commission, Director of Audit and Attorney-General.

2. The holders of the offices specified in the first column of the Schedule shall be paid the salaries set opposite thereto in the second column of the Schedule.

Duty Allowance of Chairman of a Delimitation Commission

3. The Chairman of a Delimitation Commission shall be paid a duty allowance of seven hundred rand on the date on which the Commission's report is delivered to the President.

Duty Allowances of Members of a Delimitation Commission

4. Members of a Delimitation Commission (other than the Chairman) shall on the date on which the Commission's report is delivered to the President be paid—

- (a) in the case of a member who is resident in Botswana, a duty allowance of three hundred and forty rands;
- (b) in the case of a member who is not resident in Botswana a duty allowance of five hundred and thirty rands;

Repeal of Law No. 16 of 1965

5. The Specified Offices (Salaries and Allowances) Law, 1965, is repealed.

SCHEDULE

<i>Office</i>	<i>Salary</i>
Chairman of the Public Service Commission	At the rate of six thousand four hundred and twenty rands a year.
Other Members of the Public Service Commission	At the rate of one thousand one hundred and sixty-four rands a year.
Director of Audit	At the rate of five thousand seven hundred and ninety rands a year.
Attorney-General	At the rate of six thousand four hundred and twenty rands a year.
