THE COMPANIES PROCLAMATION, 1959

THE COMPANIES (AMENDMENT OF SEVENTH SCHEDULE) NOTICE, 1969

(Published on 11th April, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 313 of the Companies Proclamation, 1959 (No. 71 of 1959) His Excellency the President hereby gives notice as follows –

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the Companies (Amendment of Seventh Schedule) Notice, 1969.

Amendment of Seventh Schedule to Proclamation No. 71 of 1959

2. The Seventh Schedule to the Companies Proclamation, 1959, is amended –

(a) in the First Table –

(i) by the deletion of paragraph (1) and the substitution of –

“(1) For registration of a company – twenty-five cents for every R200 or portion of R200 of the nominal capital of the company. In no case, however, shall the registration fee be less than R16. ”;

(ii) by the deletion of paragraph (6) and the substitution of –

“(6) For registration of any statement in lieu of the prospectus.. . . R1

(7) For the filing of an annual return in terms of section 96 or any other return required to be filed with the Registrar under the Proclamation R1

(8) For the registration of any document, or making a record of fact not previously specified.. . . . R1 . ”.

(b) in the Third Table by the deletion of paragraph (2) and the substitution of –

“(2) For inspection of any documents relating to any company filed with the Registrar –

(a) in the case of a private company 25c.

(b) in the case of a public company 50c. ”.
