**THE EMPLOYMENT (LABOUR HEALTH AREAS) ORDER
1969**

(Published on 26th September, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 104 of the Employment Law, 1963 (No. 15 of 1963), His Excellency the President makes the following Order —

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment (Labour Health Areas) Order, 1969.

Declaration of Labour Health Areas

2. The following areas are declared to be labour health areas for the purposes of the Employment Law, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) —

- (a) the area at Selebi-Pikwe within a 3 mile radius of survey point BPT 497;
- (b) the area at Orapa within a 5 mile radius of survey point BPT 489;
- (c) the area at Shashi within a 3 mile radius of the centre of the railway bridge over the Shashi River.

Application of Sections 105, 107, 108 and 111 of Law No. 15 of 1963 to Declared Labour Health Areas

3. The provisions of sections 105, 107, 108 and 111 of the principal law are applied to the labour health areas specified in the last preceding paragraph.
