**ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COUNCIL  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1969**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Local government (District Councils) Law, 1965, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order —

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Establishment of the Central District Council (Amendment) Order, 1969.

**Amendment of Section 2 of Legal Notice 41 of 1966**

2. Section 2 of the Establishment of the Central District Council Order, 1966, is amended by the deletion of subsections (2) and (3) thereof and by the substitution therefor of a new subsection as follows —

“(2) The Central District Council shall consist of —

- (a) 32 elected members;
- (b) 5 nominated members; and
- (c) the Chief or tribal authority of the Bamangwato Tribe.”
