**ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SOUTHEAST DISTRICT COUNCIL
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1969**

(Published on the 7th November, 1969)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order –

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Establishment of the Southeast District Council (Amendment) Order, 1969.

Amendment of Section 2 of Legal Notice 43 of 1966

2. Section 2 of the Establishment of the Southeast District Council Order, 1966, is amended by the deletion of subsections (2) and (3) thereof and by the substitution therefor of a new subsection as follows –

“(2) The Southeast District Council shall consist of –

- (a) 13 elected members;
- (b) 3 nominated members; and
- (c) the Chief or tribal authority of the Bamalete Tribe and the Chief or tribal authority of the Batlokwa Tribe.”
