In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 26 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (No. 22 of 1961), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs hereby gives notice as follows —

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Amendment of Schedules) Notice, 1969.

Replacement of Fourth Schedule to Proclamation No. 22 of 1961

2. The Fourth Schedule to the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is deleted and the following is substituted therefor —

Amendment of Fifth Schedule to Proclamation No. 22 of 1961

3. The Fifth Schedule to the principal law is amended by the insertion under the heading "Commuted Export Duty" after "Package C" of the following sentence — "In the case of any animals hunted under supplementary licences or under a permit issued in terms of section 34(b) as the result of the issue of a Package Licence a commuted export fee of R10."
