**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (BATAWANA TRIBAL TERRITORY)  
HUNTING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1969**

(Published on 17 January, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4(1) read with section 93 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, (No. 22 of 1961), and after consultation with the Chief of the Batawana Tribal Territory, and the appropriate District Council, the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs hereby makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Batawana Tribal Territory) Hunting (Amendment) Regulations, 1969.

**Amendment of Regulation 9 in Statutory Instrument No. 65 of 1967**

2. Regulation 9 of the Fauna Conservation (Batawana Tribal Territory) Hunting Regulations, 1967, is amended by the addition of the following proviso to subregulation (6) —

“Provided that —

- (a) a licence issued under regulation 4 may be endorsed by the Game Warden, Maun, to authorise a person nominated by the person in whose name the licence has been issued to hunt under that licence to the extent to which the last-named person has not exhausted his rights under the licence ;
- (b) a licence issued under regulation 5 may be endorsed by the Game Warden, Maun, to authorise a person nominated by the person in whose name the licence has been issued to hunt tribal game specified in Part I of the Second Schedule to these Regulations to the extent to which the last-named person has not exhausted his rights under the licence.
