**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT NO. 2)
REGULATIONS, 1969**

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 93(2) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (No. 22 of 1961), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (General) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1969.

Substitution of Form J in the First Schedule to Statutory Instrument No. 19 of 1968

2. The First Schedule to the Fauna Conservation (General) Regulations, 1968, is amended by the cancellation of Form J and the substitution therefor of Form J in the Schedule hereto.
