**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (PERMIT FEES)  
REGULATIONS, 1969**

(Published on the 5th December, 1969)

It is notified for general information that in the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 93 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (No. 22 of 1961), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs has made the following regulations—

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Permit Fees) Regulations, 1969.

**Fees for Certain Permits to Kill or Capture Certain Animals**

2. An applicant for a permit to be granted by the Chief Game Warden, under the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 34 of the Proclamation, shall pay a fee of R50.00 in respect of each Eland, Roan Antelope or Sable Antelope the killing or capture of which is authorised by such permit.
