**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (TRIBAL TERRITORIES CONTROLLED  
HUNTING AREAS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1969**

(Published on 17th January, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 11 read with section 93 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (No. 22 of 1961), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Tribal Territories Controlled Hunting Areas) (Amendment) Regulations, 1969.

**Amendment of Regulation 6 in Statutory Instrument No. 23 of 1968**

2. Regulation 6 of the Fauna Conservation (Tribal Territories Controlled Hunting Areas) Regulations, 1968, (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) is amended —

(a) in subregulation (3) by the deletion of all the words following "shall be", and the substitution therefor of "seven, fourteen, twenty-one or twenty-eight days commencing and terminating at midday on a Friday";

(b) in subregulation (4) by the addition of —

" and shall be returned to the office where it was issued within 24 hours after its expiration."

**Amendment of Second Schedule in Statutory Instrument No. 23 of 1968**

3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by the deletion of "R5.00" and "R20.00" and the substitution therefor of "R5.00 per 7 day period" and "R30.00 per 7 day period" respectively.
