**THE TOWNSHIPS PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 120)
THE GABERONES GENERAL (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS, 1969**

(Published on the 11th July, 1969)

It is notified for general information that His Excellency the President has, in terms of regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 (Legal Notice No. 37 of 1966), approved the following bye-laws made by the Gaberones Town Council in the exercise of the powers vested in it by regulation 31 of the said Regulations —

Citation

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Gaberones General (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1969.

Insertion of New Bye-Law 36A into Legal Notice No. 58 of 1966

2. The Gaberones General Bye-Laws, 1966, (hereinafter called the principal bye-laws) are amended by the insertion after bye-law 36 of the following bye-law —

“Barbed Wire Fences

36A. No person shall use, or allow to be used, barbed wire for fencing any area or lot without the written permission of the Town Council:

Provided that in the event of the refusal by the Council to give permission as aforesaid an appeal shall lie to the Minister in accordance with the provisions of regulation 33(3) of the Town Council Regulations, 1966.”

Amendment of Bye-Law No. 37 of Legal Notice No. 58 of 1966

3. The principal bye-laws are amended in subsection (1) of bye-law 37 by the deletion of “or 36” and the substitution of, “36 or 36A”.
