**THE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENCE AND CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE
REGULATIONS, 1969.**

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 54 of the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Proclamation (Chapter 168), His Excellency the President hereby makes the following regulations –

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Licence and Clearance Certificate Regulations, 1969.

Issuing of Licence and Clearance Certificate

2. (1) The licence and the clearance certificate issued in respect of a motor vehicle or trailer shall be the form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(2) On the clearance certificate the year of issue of such certificate shall be stamped in each year in such form as the registering authority shall deem fit.

Manner of affixing Clearance Certificate

3. (1) The clearance certificate shall be affixed –

(a) if the motor vehicle is fitted with a transparent windscreen, in an upright position on the inside of the windscreen in such manner that the certificate and the inscription thereon can clearly and readily be seen from the outside;

(b) if the motor vehicle is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the left side of the vehicle in such a manner that the inscription thereon is clearly legible.

(2) If the clearance certificate is affixed to a motor vehicle in a position in which it could be exposed to the elements it shall be protected in a weather-proof holder with a durable transparent cover.
