**THE NON-PENSIONABLE TEACHERS' PROVIDENT  
FUND (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1969**

(Published on 9th May, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Non-Pensionable Teachers' Provident Fund Law, 1961 (No. 27 of 1961), His Excellency the President makes the following Regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Non-Pensionable Teachers' Provident Fund (Amendment) Regulations, 1969.

**Amendment of Regulation 2 in G.N. No. 27 of 1963**

2. The Non-Pensionable Teachers' Provident Fund Regulations, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) are amended in Regulation 2 —

(a) by the deletion of the definition of "Deputy Director of Education";

(b) by the insertion of the following definition —

"Senior Education Officer" means the person for the time being holding the office of Senior Education Officer in the Public Service of Botswana;

**Amendment of Regulation 4 in G.N. No. 27 of 1963**

3. The principal regulations are amended in subregulation (1) of Regulation 4 —

(a) in paragraph (b) by the deletion of "Deputy Director of Education" and the substitution therefor of "Senior Education Officer";

(b) in paragraph (c) by the deletion of "Association" and the substitution therefor of "Union".

**Amendment of Regulation 11 in G.N. No. 27 of 1963**

4. The principal regulations are amended in subregulation (2) of Regulation 11 by the deletion of "as accruing in respect of each such amount with effect from the first day of the month following the month on which the amount was paid into the Fund:" and the substitution therefor of "on the balances standing to the credit of the depositors and employers on the last day of the previous financial year plus one half of the deposits and contributions made during the financial year:".

**Amendment of Regulation 13 in G.N. No. 27 of 1963**

5. The principal regulations are amended in subregulation (2) of Regulation 13 —

(a) in paragraphs (a) and (b) by the deletion of "contributor" and the substitution therefor of "depositor";

(b) in paragraph (b) by the addition of — "and the depositor or his legal representative, as the case may be, shall be entitled to claim payment of such amount."

**Revocation of Regulation 14 in G.N. No. 27 of 1963**

6. Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is revoked.

**Amendment of Regulation 16 in G.N. No. 27 of 1963**

7. The principal regulations are amended in Regulation 16 —

(a) by the deletion of subregulations (2) and (3);

(b) by the insertion of the following subregulation, the present subregulation (1) becoming subregulation (2) —

“(1) If for a period of one year there have been moneys standing unclaimed in a depositor’s account and the whereabouts of the depositor, or his legal representative, as the case may be, are unknown, the Accountant-General shall cause the name of the depositor to be published in the *Gazette*.”;

(c) by the addition to subregulation (2) of —

“, the account shall be closed and the moneys in such account shall accrue to the Fund.”
