

**Statutory Instrument No. 114 of 1969**

**THE PRECIOUS STONES INDUSTRY (PROTECTION) ACT, 1969**  
**THE ORAPA PRECIOUS STONE SECURITY AREA ORDER, 1969**

(Published on the 28th November, 1969)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 26 of the Precious Stones Industry (Protection) Act, 1969, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling and with the consent of the holder of the relevant mining right the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs makes the following Order:

**Citation**

1. This order may be cited as the Orapa Precious Stone Security Area Order, 1969.

**Declaration of Area**

2. The mining area defined in the schedule to this Order declared to be a Precious Stone Security Area.

**SCHEDULE**

Commencing at a point the approximate Lo 25 coordinates of which are Y - 123590, X + 7727550 the boundary runs eastwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 125130, X + 7727550; thence south-eastwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 128000, X + 7729320; thence continuing south-eastwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 130000, X + 7730340; thence southwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 130000, X + 7735840; thence south-westwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 127530, X + 7738770; thence southwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 127530, X + 7744530; thence westwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 120000, X + 7744280; thence northwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 120000, X + 7740580; thence north eastwards to a point with approximate coordinates Y - 123590, X + 7735820; thence northwards to the point of commencement.
