**THE PRICE CONTROL (RETAIL PETROL  
PRICES) REGULATIONS, 1969.**

(Published on 22nd August, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 3 of the Price Control Law, 1962 (No. 26 of 1962), as read with Sections 4(2) and 17(1) of the Botswana Independence Order, 1966, His Excellency the President makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as The Price Control (Retail Petrol Prices) Regulations, 1969.

**Retail Prices of Petrol**

2. A person shall not sell petrol by retail either personally or through an agent at a price which exceeds the price at which such petrol has been delivered to such person by more than three cents per gallon.

**Offence**

3. Any person who contravenes Regulation 2 shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine of R200 or, in default of payment, imprisonment for six months or to both such fine and such imprisonment.
