PROHIBITED PUBLICATIONS (NO. 2) ORDER, 1969

(Published on 15th August, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 48(1) of the Penal Code (Law No. 2 of 1964), His Excellency the President, being of the opinion that there is in publications published by the undermentioned associations of persons matter which is contrary to the public interest, makes the following Order —

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Publications (No. 2) Order, 1969.

Declaration of Prohibited Publications

2. All publications of every class published by —

- (a) The International Union of Students, of Prague, Czechoslovakia;
- (b) The Secretariat of the Afro-Asian Journalists Association, of Peking, China;
- (c) The Progressive Labor Party, of New York, United States of America;

are declared to be prohibited publications.
