**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION (DELEGATION OF POWERS)
(AMENDMENT) DIRECTIONS, 1969**

(Published on 21st March, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in it by section 111(3) of the Constitution, the Public Service Commission, with the consent of the President, gives the following directions —

Citation

1. These directions may be cited as the Public Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) (Amendment) Directions, 1969.

Amendment of Schedule to S.I. No. 66 of 1967

2. The Schedule to the Public Service Commission (Delegation of Powers) Directions, 1967, is amended in section 3 by the addition of the following paragraph —

“(d) to the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Education, Health and Labour power to appoint persons as Student Nurses and Pupil Midwives, to exercise disciplinary control over persons holding or acting in such offices, and to remove such persons from office.”
