**RATES OF DUTY (SOUTH AFRICAN SPIRITS, BEER AND WINES)
ORDER, 1969**

(Published on the 10th January, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3(3) read with section 7 of the Customs Duties on South African Spirits, Beer and Wines Law, 1965 (No. 10 of 1965), the Minister of Finance makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates of Duty (South African Spirits, Beer and Wines) Order, 1969, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st October, 1968.

Amendment of Schedule of Law No. 10 of 1965

2. The Schedule to the Customs Duties on South African Spirits, Beer and Wines Law, 1965, as replaced by Legal Notice No. 87 of 1966 and further amended by Statutory Instrument No. 47 of 1968, is hereby further amended in paragraph B, which relates to Beer, by the deletion in subparagraph (a) of —

“plus a suspended duty of, per gallon 12½”.
