**THE REVISED EDITION OF LAWS (COMMONWEALTH
STATUTES ACT) ORDER, 1969**

(Published on 21st February, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Revised Edition of Laws Act, 1968 (No. 50 of 1968) His Excellency the President hereby makes the following order —

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Revised Edition of Laws (Commonwealth Statutes Act) Order, 1968.

Citation of 7 Edw. 7 c. 16

2. The Evidence (Colonial Statutes) Act, 1907, as applied to Botswana by virtue of the provisions of the Order in Council of the 18th October, 1909, as amended by the Order in Council of the 14th December, 1922 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) may be cited as the Evidence (Commonwealth Statutes) Act, 1907.

Amendment of Section 1 of 7 Edw. 7 c. 16

3. Section 1 of the principal law is amended —

- (a) except in the definition of "British possession", by the deletion of "British possession" and "British possessions" wherever they appear, and the substitution of "Commonwealth country" and "Commonwealth countries";
- (b) by the deletion in subsection (1) of "the United Kingdom" and the substitution of "Botswana";
- (c) in subsection (3) by the deletion of "possession" wherever it appears in the definition of "Government Printer" and the substitution of "country";
- (d) in subsection (3) by the deletion of the definition of "British possession" and the substitution of "'Commonwealth country' where parts of a Commonwealth country are under both a central and a local Legislature shall include both all parts under the central Legislature and each part under a local Legislature";
- (e) by the deletion of subsections (4) and (5).
