**THE REVISED EDITION OF LAWS (EVIDENCE (1851 ACT))
ORDER, 1969**

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8(3) of the Revised Edition of Laws Act, 1968 (No. 50 of 1968) His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order —

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Revised Edition of Laws (Evidence (1851 Act)) Order, 1969.

Citation of Sections 7 & 11 of 14 & 15 Vict. c. 99

2. Sections 7 and 11 of the Evidence Act, 1851, as applied to Botswana under the provisions of the South African Protectorates (Extension of Imperial Acts) Order in Council, 1911 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) may be cited as the Evidence (1851 Act).

Amendment of Section 7 of 14 & 15 Vict. c. 99

3. Section 7 of the principal law is amended —

- (a) in the side note by the deletion of "Colonial" and the substitution of "Commonwealth";
- (b) by the deletion of "British Colony" wherever it appears, and the substitution of "Commonwealth Country";
- (c) by the deletion of "colonial court" wherever it appears and the substitution of "Commonwealth court".

Amendment of Section 11 of 14 & 15 Vict. c. 99

4. Section 11 of the principal law is amended —

- (a) in the side-note by the deletion of "the colonies" and the substitution of "Botswana";
- (b) by the deletion of "any of the British colonies" and the substitution of "Botswana".
