**THE PUBLIC HEALTH PROCLAMATION**

**THE SANITARY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1969**

(Published on 19th September, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Public Health Proclamation (Cap. 40 of the 1948 Edition of the Laws), His Excellency the President hereby makes the following regulations –

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Sanitary (Amendment) Regulations, 1969.

**Amendment of Regulation 1 in G.N. No. 116 of 1934**

2. Regulation 1 of the Sanitary Regulations, 1934 (published at page 185 of Vol. III of the 1948 Edition of the Laws and hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations) is amended by the deletion of subregulation (3) and the substitution thereof –

“(3) “local authority” shall mean a Town Council or a District Council.”

**Amendment of Regulation 21 in G.N. No. 116 of 1934**

3. Regulation 21 of the principal regulations is amended by the deletion of the reference to Serondellas and a related area and by the insertion immediately after the reference to Kanye and a related area of –

“Kasane Within a radius of 2 miles from the Post Office.”
