**THE MOTOR VEHICLE AND ROAD TRAFFIC PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 168)**

**THE SPEED LIMIT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1969**

(Published on the 11th July, 1969)

In the execution of the powers vested on him by Section 34(1) of the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Proclamation (Chapter 168), His Excellency the President makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Speed Limit (Amendment) Regulations, 1969.  
**Manner of Citing H.C.N. No. 118 of 1961**

2. High Commissioner's Notice No. 118 of 1961 may be cited as the Speed Limit Notice, No. 1961.

**Amendment of Schedule to H.C.N. No. 118 of 1961**

3. The Schedule to the Speed Limit Notice, 1961, is amended —

(a) By the deletion of items 1 and 2 and the substitution therefor of the following—

“1. The Gaborones Township as defined from time to time in terms of Section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120).

2. The Francistown Township as defined from time to time in terms of Section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120).”

(b) by the addition of the following items after item 11 —

“12. The area within a radius of three miles from the Post Office at Tonota in the Ngwato district.

13. The area within a radius of three miles from the Police Station at Ramoutsa.”
