(CHAPTER 5)

THE SUBORDINATE COURTS (DISTRICTS)
NOTICE, 1969

(Published on 14th March, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Subordinate Courts Proclamation (Chapter 5), the Minister of State prescribes the several areas described in the Schedule hereto as districts for the purposes of the said Proclamation, hereby revoking all previous Notices prescribing areas as districts for the said purposes.

SCHEDULE

1. *Northern Magisterial District*

The area which comprises the Ngamiland Administrative District, the Chobe Administrative District, the Northeast Administrative District, the Francistown Administrative District, that part of the Central Administrative District north of Latitude 21° South together with a strip of land the boundaries of which are defined as commencing at a point on the Tuli Circle 5 miles distant from the right bank of the Shashi River measured perpendicularly thence generally westwards and northwards following a line 5 miles distant from the right bank of the Shashi River measured perpendicularly, to the intersection of this line with Latitude 21° South, thence eastwards along Latitude 21° South to its intersection with the right bank of the Shashi River thence generally southwards and eastwards along the right bank of the Shashi River to its intersection with the Tuli Circle thence generally southwards along the Tuli Circle to the point of commencement.

2. *Serowe Magisterial District*

That part of the Central Administrative District not included in the Northern Magisterial District.

3. *The Gaborones Magisterial District*

The area which comprises the Kweneng Administrative District, the Kgatleng Administrative District, the Gaborones Administrative District and that portion of the Southeast Administrative District north of the southern boundary of the farm Crocodile Pools No. 15 - KO.

4. *The Southwest Magisterial District*

The area which comprises the Ghanzi Administrative District, the Kgalagadi Administrative District, the Ngwaketse Administrative District, the Lobatsi Administrative District and that portion of the Southeast Administrative District not included in the Gaborones Magisterial District.
