THE TOWNSHIPS PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 120)

**THE TOWN COUNCIL (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS
1969**

(Published on 7th February, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120), His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Town Council (Amendment) Regulations, 1969.

Substitution of Regulation 15 in Legal Notice No. 37 of 1966

2. Regulation 15 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966, is deleted and the following substituted therefor —

“Qualifications of Voters

15. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) —

- (a) any person who is registered as a voter for the purpose of elections of Elected Members of the National Assembly and enrolled in a Voters Roll prepared and certified in terms of the Electoral Act, 1968, for the area, or any part of the area, in respect of which a Council has been established shall be entitled to vote in any election of members of the Council;
- (b) any person who has attained the age of 21 years who is lawfully resident in Botswana and has been so resident for a continuous period of at least twelve months immediately preceding the date on which he applies for registration shall be entitled to register as a voter and, when registered and enrolled, to vote in any election of members of a council unless he is subject to any of the disqualifications set out in section 6(1) (b), (c) and (d) of the Electoral Act, 1968.

(2) —

- (a) No person shall be entitled to vote in more than one area, or part of one area, in respect of which a Council has been established;
- (b) a person shall be entitled to vote only in the area in which he resides;
- (c) a person who has more than one place of residence shall be entitled to vote only in the area where his principal residence is situated.”
