

2. Amendment of section 286 of the Companies Proclamation, 1959

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE COMPANIES PROCLAMATION, 1959 BY GIVING POWER TO EXEMPT FROM COMPLYING WITH CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED ON EXTERNAL COMPANIES**

*Date of Assent* : 27.7.1971.

*Date of Commencement* : 6.8.1971.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Companies Proclamation (Amendment) Act, 1971.

**2.** Section 286 of the Companies Proclamation, 1959, is amended by the addition thereto of a new subsection as follows:—

“(8) The Minister may, on application to him in writing, exempt an external company from such of the requirements imposed by this section as he considers reasonable.”
