

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONTROL OF LIVESTOCK  
INDUSTRY PROCLAMATION.**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Control of Livestock Industry (Amendment) Act, 1971. Short title

**2.** The Control of Livestock Industry Proclamation, hereinafter referred to as the principal Law, is amended by the insertion therein immediately after section 6 thereof of a new section as follows — Insertion of

6A in  
Chapter 109

\*Fee for  
permits.

6A. (1) The President may make regulations prescribing the fees which may be charged on the issue of a chief's or district officer's permit for each head of livestock covered by such permit.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1) such regulations may prescribe —

- (a) different fees for different types of livestock; and

(b) different fees for different tribal and non-tribal areas.”.

Validation

**3.** Any fees collected prior to the coming into force of this Act for the issue of any chief's or district officer's permit under section 3 of the principal Law shall be deemed to have been due under such Law and to have been validly collected and no action shall lie in any court to recover any such fee as shall have been collected.
