

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE EDUCATION LAW, 1966, BY SUBSTITUTING REFERENCES TO THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION FOR REFERENCES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND BY PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND DISESTABLISHMENT OF GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS, AND TO RATIFY THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CERTAIN GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS HERETOFORE ESTABLISHED.**

*Date of Assent:* 27.7.1971.

*Date of Commencement:* 6.8.1971.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Education (Amendment) Act, Short title 1971.

**2.** The references in the Education Law, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law), to the Department, signifying the Department of Education, and to the Department of Education are deleted wherever they occur and there are substituted therefor references to the Ministry and the Ministry of Education respectively.

3. Section 3 of the principal law is amended by the insertion immediately after subsection (1) of the following subsection, the present subsection (2) becoming subsection (3) —

“(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1) the Minister may by order in the Gazette establish or disestablish such Government schools as he may deem it proper to establish or disestablish, as the case may be.”.

4. The establishment as Government schools of the schools whose names are given in the Schedule is ratified and confirmed with effect from the respective dates set opposite their names, and the said schools shall be deemed to have been Government schools for the purposes of the principal law from the said dates, save that the Gaborone Secondary School, the Lobatse Teacher Training College and the Serowe Teacher Training College shall be deemed to have been Government schools for the purposes of the principal law from the date of commencement of the principal law.
