AN ACT TO AMEND THE MINES AND MINERALS ACT, 1967, BY PROVIDING FOR THE ATTACHING OF TERMS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS TO CONSENTS TO THE SUB-LETTING, TRANSFER OR HYPOTHECATION OF STATE GRANTS OF MINING LEASES.

Date of Commencement: 7.5.1971

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Mines and Minerals (Amendment) Act, 1971.

Amendment
of Section 35
of Act No. 50
of 1967

2. Section 35 of the Mines and Minerals Act, 1967, is amended by the insertion after subsection (1) of the following subsection, the present subsections (2) and (3) becoming subsections (3) and (4) —

“(2) If he grants a consent in terms of subsection (1), the Minister may attach thereto such terms, conditions and restrictions as he may deem desirable in the public interest whether or not such terms, conditions and restrictions are relevant to the purposes of this Act.”
