AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE PAYMENT OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND AND THE DEVELOPMENT FUND OF SUMS OF MONEY FOR THE YEAR ENDING ON THE 31ST MARCH, 1971, TO MEET SUPPLEMENTARY EXPENDITURE APPROVED BY RESOLUTION DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1970/1971

Date of Assent: 31.3.1971.

Date of Commencement: 1.4.1971.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Short title (1970/1971) Act, 1971.

Expenditure from Consolidated Fund **2.** Subject to the provisions of section 3 the Minister of Finance and Development Planning may issue a warrant for the payment from the Consolidated Fund for the year ending on the 31st March, 1971, of the sum of R2,409,939 (two-million, four-hundred and nine-thousand, nine-hundred and thirty-nine rand).

Appropriation **3.** (1) The sum authorised by section 2 is appropriated to and shall be applied for the purposes of the heads of expenditure set out in the First and Second columns of the First Schedule, in the amounts set opposite thereto in the Third column of that Schedule.

(2) Any monies withdrawn from the Consolidated Fund for any head of expenditure specified in the First Schedule in pursuance of any resolution of the National Assembly passed during the financial year ending 31st March, 1971, shall be set off against the amount provided for that head by this Act.

Expenditure from Development Fund **4.** Subject to the provisions of section 5 the Minister of Finance and Development Planning may issue a warrant for the payment from the Development Fund for the year ending on the 31st March, 1971, of the sum of R15,811,626 (fifteen-million, eight-hundred and eleven thousand, six-hundred and twenty-six rand).

Appropriation **5.** (1) The sum authorised by section 4 is appropriated to and shall be applied for the purposes of the heads of expenditure set out in the First and Second columns of the Second Schedule, in the amounts set opposite thereto in the Third column of that Schedule.

(2) Any monies withdrawn from the Development Fund for any head of expenditure specified in the Second Schedule in pursuance of any resolution of the National Assembly passed during the financial year ending 31st March, 1971, shall be set off against the amount provided for that head by this Act.
