AN ACT TO AMEND THE TRIBAL TERRITORIES PROCLAMATION BY INCORPORATING THEREIN A NEW DESCRIPTION OF THE BATLOKWA TRIBAL TERRITORY

Date of Assent: 15.4.1971.

Date of Commencement: 23.4.1971.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Tribal Territories (Amendment) Act, 1971.

Repeal and Replacement of Section 8 of Chapter 68

2. Section 8 of the Tribal Territories Proclamation is repealed and replaced by a new section as follows —

“Boundary of the Batlokwa Tribal Territory.

8. The boundary of the Batlokwa Tribal Territory is as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the middle of the Notwane River and the boundary of the farm Kenmoir No. 1 – KP represented by the line AB on diagram DSL 1882/1912 of the farm Kenmoir No. 1 – KP the boundary runs southeastwards to the beacon lettered “B” on diagram DSL No. 1882/1912; thence continuing southeastwards to the beacon lettered “C” on diagram DSL 1980/1918 of Portion 1 (Fairfield) of the farm Kenmoir No. 1 – KP; thence northeastwards to the beacon lettered “D” on diagram DSL 1980/1918; thence southeastwards to the beacon lettered “A” on diagram DSL No. 1980/1918; thence northeastwards to the beacon lettered “C” on diagram DSL No. 1882/1912 of the farm Kenmoir No. 1 – KP and lettered “A” on

diagram DSL No. 1883/1912 of the farm Clent No. 2 - KP; thence southeastwards to the beacon lettered "Md" on diagram DSL No. 1883/1912 and lettered "Md" on diagram No. 3384/1922 of the farm Almond Hill No. 3 - KP; thence southeastwards to the beacon lettered "VIII" on diagram DSL No. 3384/1922 and lettered "VIII" on diagram DSL No. 581/1912 of the farm Gaborone Block No. 6 - KO; thence southwestwards to the beacon lettered "VII" on diagram DSL No. 581/1912; thence southwestwards to the beacon lettered "B" on diagram DSL No. 21/1916 of the farm Notwane No. 14 - KO; thence northwestwards through the beacon lettered "A" on diagram DSL No. 21/1916 to the intersection of the boundary of the farm Notwane No. 14 - KO represented by the prolongation of the line BA on diagram DSL No. 21/1916 with the middle of the Notwane River; thence downstream generally northeastwards following the middle of the Notwane River to the point of commencement.

The diagrams referred to in the above description are filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone."
