**ABOLITION OF PUBLIC OFFICE (DEPUTY FINANCIAL SECRETARY)
ORDER, 1971**

Order made by His Excellency the President in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 24A of the Interpretation and General Provisions Law, 1966, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. This Order may be cited as the Abolition of Public Office (Deputy Financial Secretary) Order, 1971.
2. The Office of Deputy Financial Secretary is abolished with effect from the 14th May, 1971.
3. The functions vested under any law in the Deputy Financial Secretary shall, with effect from the publication of this Order, vest in the Director of Financial Affairs.
