FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961
(22 of 1961)

DECLARATION OF KHUTSE GAME RESERVE

(Published on the 25th June, 1971)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 His Excellency the President has declared the areas of land within the boundaries specified in the Schedule hereto to be a game reserve in respect of all animals.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at a point fifteen miles due north of Borehole No. 302 at Dutfwe Village the boundary runs due east to a point on the line of longitude which passes through a point fifteen miles due west of Borehole No. 735 at Mosero, thence in a straight line in a north-easterly direction passing through a point one and one-and-a-half miles due east of the most eastern edge of Galalabadimo Pan to its intersection with the northern boundary of the Bakwena Tribal Territory; thence westwards following the said Bakwena Tribal Territory boundary to a point on the boundary due north of the point of commencement, thence due south to the point of commencement.
