FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961
(22 OF 1961)

DECLARATION OF PRIVATE GAME RESERVES (NO. 2)

(Published on the 8th April, 1971)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 His Excellency the President has declared the areas of private land described in the Schedule hereto to be private game reserves for the protection and preservation therein of wild animal life, subject to the following conditions —

- (a) persons authorised thereto in accordance with section 16 of the Proclamation, as read with section 9 of the Proclamation, may hunt game on the said land in accordance with the said sections as read with section 49 of the Proclamation; and
- (b) the holder of a Minister's licence granted under section 31 of the Proclamation may hunt game on the said land in accordance with section 9 of the Proclamation.
