THE TOWNSHIPS PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 120)
THE TOWN COUNCIL REGULATIONS, 1966
THE GABORONE (OPERATION OF POUND) BYE-LAWS, 1971

(Published on the 12th March, 1971)

It is hereby notified that the Minister of Local Government and Lands has, in terms of regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 (Legal Notice No. 37 of 1966), approved the following bye-laws made by the Gaborone Town Council under the provisions of section 31 of the aforesaid regulations —

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Gaborone (Operation of Citation Pound) Bye-Laws, 1971.
2. In these bye-laws —
"Council" means the Gaborone Town Council;
"township" means Gaborone Township.
Interpretation
3. These bye-laws shall apply within the limits of the township. Application
4. The Council shall operate a pound which shall be situated within the limits of the township. Operation of Pound
5. The Council shall appoint a poundmaster and such other persons as are necessary for the proper conduct of a pound. Appointment of Poundmaster
6. The poundmaster shall comply with those provisions of the Pounds Proclamation (Chapter 140) which are in force within the township. Moneys to be paid into Funds of Council
7. All moneys received by the poundmaster in terms of the Pounds Proclamation shall be paid into the funds of the Council. Financing of Pound
8. The cost of providing the pound and all other moneys lawfully expended by the poundmaster shall be defrayed by the Council. Financing of Pound
