(Chapter 162)

**THE IMPORT CONTROL (WHOLE MAIZE, MAIZE PRODUCTS
AND MAIZE MEAL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1971**

(Published on the 5th November, 1971)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation and of all other powers thereunto him enabling, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following regulations--

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Import Control (Whole Maize, Maize Products and Maize Meal) (Amendment) Regulations, 1971.

2. The Importation Control (Whole Maize, Maize Products and Maize Meal) Regulations, 1970, are amended by the repeal of regulation 3 thereof and by the substitution thereof of a new regulation as follows --

3. It shall be a condition of any permission to import whole maize, maize products or maize meal from South Africa that the importer pays --

- (i) in respect of whole maize imported in metric ton units the sum of 110 cents per metric ton;
- (ii) in respect of whole maize or maize products imported other than in metric ton units the sum of 10 cents per 90 kilograms; and
- (iii) in respect of maize meal the sum of 20 cents per 80 kilograms,

or such lesser sum as may be fixed by South Africa as the export levy on whole maize, maize products or maize meal exported to Botswana."
