Citation           **1.** These Rules may be cited as the Rules of the Subordinate Courts, (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules, 1971.

Amendment of Order XXXVII of S.I. 107 of 1970           **2.** Order XXXVII, rule 5, of the Subordinate Court Rules, 1970, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules) is amended by the insertion immediately after the words "from the instance, shall" appearing therein of the word "not".

Insertion of new Order XLA in S.I. 107 of 1970           **3.** The principal Rules are amended by the insertion, immediately after Order XL, of a new Order --  
"ORDER XLA

**TARIFF OF ALLOWANCES PAYABLE TO WITNESSES IN  
CIVIL PROCEEDINGS IN THE SUBORDINATE COURTS**

**1.** A witness attending upon subpoena in any civil proceeding shall be paid subsistence and transport allowances at the same rates as are provided in the tariff for witnesses in criminal proceedings (Legal Notice No. 103/66).

**2.** Public servants attending as witnesses shall deal with the allowances received as laid down in departmental regulations or instructions."
