THE SELEBI-PIKWE TOWNSHIP REGULATIONS, 1970
THE SELEBI-PIKWE (POUND) BYE-LAWS, 1971

(Published on the 2nd April, 1971)

In terms of regulation 16 of the Selebi-Pikwe Township Regulations, 1970 (Statutory Instrument No. 81 of 1970), the Minister of Local Government and Lands has approved of the following bye-laws made by the Selebi-Pikwe Township Authority in the exercise of the powers vested in it by the said regulation —

| Citation | 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Selebi-Pikwe (Pound) Bye-Laws, 1971. |
| Inter-pretation | 2. In these bye-laws —
“township” means Selebi-Pikwe Township;
“Township Authority” means Selebi-Pikwe Township Authority. |
| Application | 3. These bye-laws shall apply within the limits of the township. |
| Establishment and operation of pound | 4. The Township Authority shall establish and operate a pound or pounds which shall be situated within the limits of the township. |
| Appointment of pound-master | 5. The Township Authority shall appoint a poundmaster and such other persons as are necessary for the proper conduct of any pound established under bye-law 4. |
| Duties of poundmaster | 6. The poundmaster shall comply with those provisions of the Pounds Proclamation (Chapter 140) which are in force within the township. |
| Moneys to be paid into funds of Township Authority | 7. All moneys received by the poundmaster in terms of the Pounds Proclamation (Chapter 140) shall be paid into the funds of the Township Authority. |
| Financing of pound | 8. The cost of providing the pound or pounds and all moneys lawfully expended by the poundmaster in connection therewith shall be defrayed by the Township Authority. |
